Mallacoota Golf Club has completed yet another year of growth and increasing financial stability with a deficit reduction from \$46,586 in 2018 to a current deficit of only \$5,057. Treasurer, Leigh Cockburn, has worked well with Bookkeeper, Jennifer Warren, Secretary, Celia Wallace, and Accountants and Auditors at Crowe Horwath, to produce high standards of disclosure in the accounts, which reflects another good financial year for MGCC.

The President thanked each member of the outgoing Committee of Management for their commitment, support and voluntary work undertaken in the management of the Club and thanked the Women's Golf Sub-committees and the Men's Golf Sub-committee for their contribution to the smooth running of golf tournaments and weekly golfing events. Much work goes on behind the scenes to run these successful events and tournaments.

Membership

Membership remains consistent with 84 Full members, 8 new Junior members (none in the previous year), 16 Country members and 26 Social members.

Member Fee Changes - January 2020

The following two changes were adopted at the AGM in July 2019.

80 + Membership - Commencing on the 1st January 2020, Playing Members 80 + years of age will be required to pay 50% of the full membership amount, plus affiliation fees.

New Member Joining Fee – Commencing the 1st January 2020, the current New Member joining fee of \$40 will be discontinued.

Grants

The Committee of Management submitted an application to Sports Australia Community Sport Infrastructure Grant for \$170,000.00 to improve three essential areas of the Club House (Male and Female toilets, replacement carpet, chairs and tables). It was an extremely competitive process, but unfortunately the club was unsuccessful. Feedback from EGSC indicated the application was considered to be of a very high quality in a very competitive field of Australia-wide contenders.

The Committee of Management engaged the services of Vernon Darby, Design Consultant, Mallacoota, to draw up the plans for renovations to the toilets. The Committee is very grateful for these excellent plans which are still current and can be used for future submissions.

Equipment Purchases

Equipment purchased throughout the year included: Hedge trimmer, Sylvan sprayer, Fairway mower, Whipper snipper, two Fire extinguishers, Bar Glass Washer, Cash Register, Window Drop Banner for Advertising in main street, Sound System and Microphone and two second-hand Golf Carts (a great addition to the fleet).

Re-Vegetation Management Plan

During the year, the committee received a letter from the East Gippsland Shire Council stating that vegetation was removed behind the 12th Tee without a planning permit. The Club received a fine and were instructed to develop a revegetation management plan.

In response to East Gippsland Shire Council Planning Infringement Notice No. 37/2018/ENF, the Committee of Management employed Andrew Nixon to prepare a Revegetation Management Plan to replant the area behind the 12th Tee. The plan was adopted, and replanting is well underway.





Grounds

Grounds Manager, John Bell, and volunteers are to be congratulated for their work in maintaining and improving the course. An average of six volunteers assist John weekly, with a variety of tasks. The club is indeed fortunate to have volunteers who have skills in horticulture, greens and fairway mowing, branch clearing, carpentry, welding, weed control, or just all round hard yakka with a shovel. Whilst all volunteers are recognised and appreciated, special thanks go to volunteer, Graeme Dempster, for the work he has undertaken planting garden beds along the side and back of the second and third green. They look amazing!

Golf Shop

The Golf Shop is a great asset to the club and Carol Reinelt does an excellent job collecting green fees, hiring clubs and carts, and juggling cart hire during major tournaments.

Rar

Club members greatly appreciate the Bar Manager, Kerri Warren, and bar staff for their dedication, attention to detail and interest in the well-being of members and guests. Kerri has been proactive in organising many music events throughout the year, which has attracted members and visitors to the Club.

The Committee of Management authorised the purchase of a new cash register which has simplified end-of-day procedures and financial accountability, overall, for the bar staff.

Brian and Pam Bobbin have run the Thursday raffles, which have been a great draw card and well-attended by members and guests. The raffles not only support the club but greatly benefit the kitchen contractor with an increase in patronage and meals on the night.

Compliance and Legal Requirements

The Committee of Management is required to ensure that the Club meets relevant legislation and legal requirements in order to operate.

Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation

MGCC complies with the Liquor Licensing regulations and all bar staff training requirements are up to date.

Essential Safety Measures

MGCC contracts East Gippsland Building Surveyors to undertake quarterly audits on all buildings in accordance with the Building Act 1993 and Building Regulations 2006. This year an alarm and additional lighting was installed in the cool room, two additional fire extinguishers were installed in the work sheds, fire extinguisher signage was updated, and some extinguisher signs repositioned.

Fire Safety

CFA continues to undertake six-monthly audits of fire appliances and equipment.

Emergency Lighting

Dean Shaw Electrics continues to undertake annual emergency lighting checks.

Bus Safety

In 2019, Bus Safety Victoria undertook an annual *bus safety audit* of the MGCC Courtesy Bus. MGCC were judged 100% compliant and, were accredited to operate a courtesy bus service in Victoria.

Insurance

MGCC is insured through Austbroker Country Wide for Personal Accident (voluntary workers), Vehicle Insurance (bus), Property Damage and Business Interruption, and General Liability.

Backflow Prevention

MGCC has engaged "Christy's Waste" as the accredited agent to undertake the pumping of the septic tanks and cleaning of the grease trap at the Club, in accordance with EPA Victoria Environment Protections Regulations 1998.

Food Safety

East Gippsland Shire council conducted a food safety audit that resulted in 100% compliance. The kitchen contractor is responsible for food safety in the kitchen, but the Committee of Management is responsible to ensure compliance is up-to-date and that relevant maintenance has been maintained.


